

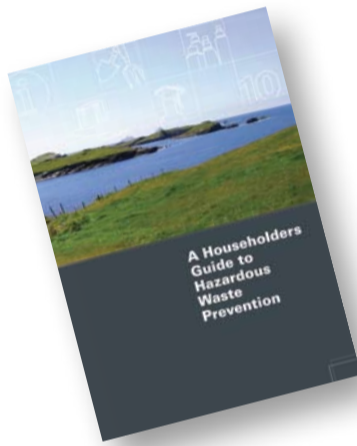
LIMERICK CLARE KERRY

A key component of the Limerick Clare Kerry waste management plan is waste prevention and resource efficiency. Participation in the EPA's Local Authority Prevention Network has seen initiatives progressed across the whole region with a wide variety of organisations and businesses. Our region is diverse so our projects and efforts mirror this:

- The visitor destinations working with us attract combined visitors of 2.5 million per annum
- The sporting venues/event destinations working with us will attract over 300,000 spectators and 800,000 users in 2010
- There are 4 acute hospitals and over 30 other significant private, voluntary and HSE facilities that we will assist with capacity building for waste prevention.
- There are 150,545 households in this region that will be targeted for household hazardous waste prevention.
- We participate and actively promote the GHA programme, the Green Business Initiative, EWR as well as other local prevention initiatives.
- The Sustainable Parks Management Project in Limerick City is the first of its kind nationwide
- There are 30 diverse companies participating in a peninsula wide prevention programme in Kerry & it is hoped to replicate this in West Clare
- A resource efficiency programme will be piloted across a rural town with a view to extending this experience across the region.
- There is over 2000 staff employed by local authorities in this region who receive messages, training & advice on resource efficiency & waste prevention.
